General Trip Description: We are looking for people to participate in one, two, or three week, multi-faceted short-term experiences.

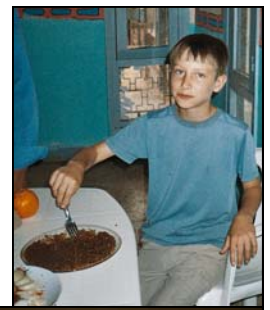
- **TIMBUKTU, MALI** (February 2010): medical clinics, kids activities, refurbishing a guest house, women's health classes
- **TUNISIA** (March 2010): work with special needs' children, dance activities, teaching English
- **LIBERIA** (June/July 2010): teacher training, training of church leaders, summer camps for kids, activities in orphanages
- **MOROCCO** (July 2010): kids sports & arts camp, orphanage visits, work in girls' detention center & special needs' centers, women's ministry, physical & occupation therapy, village visits

Things to Know

- There will be several hours of orientation in preparation for this cross-cultural experience, designed to help each team member to feel more comfortable and excited as he/she enters a very different setting.
- We are looking for people of all ages who love working with children through sports, games, crafts, puppetry, or teaching English. We are also looking for women who have interest in various crafts such as sewing, crocheting, and beading which could be shared with local village women.
- Students are welcomed and encouraged to be a part of the teams. Young people aged 16-18 will need parental consent. Those under 16 would need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Prepare to be blessed deeply as you help bring the light and love of Christ to these beautiful and hospitable people

The cost of these trips will vary depending mostly on airfare & in-country transportation. Costs do include all transportation, travel insurance, meals, activities & accommodations.



TIMELINE

- The first thing that will be required is a completed application and a \$100 non-refundable deposit.
- The next step will be sending out support letters & raising necessary funds.
- Payments will be broken into 3 installments with the first installment being the largest to cover the airline ticket.
- There will be required orientation meetings that will be announced once the team is determined.
