Lifeline Academy & Institute

Compassion Corps is working alongside of our partner Sam Flomo and Lifeline Network to construct an education building that will house a primary/high school and an Institute training nurse's aides and lab technicians. Lifeline Academy & Institute is a part of a larger community effort that includes the Healthline Clinic & Maternity Annex, a local church run by our partners, a provisions store & a water well that provides clean drinking water to anyone in the community who needs it. When Covid hit in 2020, all construction projects shut down as people were not allowed to travel into other counties. This meant that the construction of the Lifeline Academy was put on hold until early 2021.

Thankfully construction was able to begin again in March and they are working on phase 3 of the project which is the laying of the cement slab. Compassion Corps has the funds to complete phase 3, but are working to raise an additional \$21,000 in 2022 to finish the following work:

- Phase 4: masonry work \$4500
- Phase 5: form work \$2700
- Phase 6: roofing work \$4500
- Phase 7: ceiling work \$1650
- Phase 8: electrical work \$1875
- Phase 9: plastering work \$1525
- Phase 10: doors and windows \$2400
- Phase 11: painting work \$1375
